2. Use implicit differentiation to find dy/dx given $x^3 + 4xy^3 + y^4 = 150$.

3. Find an equation for the line tangent to the curve $y^4 - x^2y + 4x - 3y - 1 = 0$ at the point $(3, 1)$.

4. Find an equation for a tangent line to the curve $x^2 - y^2 = 5$ that goes through the point $(1, 1)$.
(Note that the point $(1, 1)$ is not on the curve.)

3. A hot air balloon is ascending at the rate of 20 m/sec at a height 100 m above the ground when a brick is dropped from the balloon. How long does it take for the brick to reach the ground? With what speed does it hit the ground? Note that the initial velocity of the brick is not 0. (Have you ever stepped out of a moving car?) You may use a calculator for the necessary computations.

3. For the function $f(x) = xe^{-x/4}$, determine the intervals on which f is concave up and those on which f is concave down. Also, find the (x, y) coordinates of any inflection points.

4. Find a polynomial P of degree 3 so that P has an inflection point at $(1, 6)$ and a y -intercept of 4.

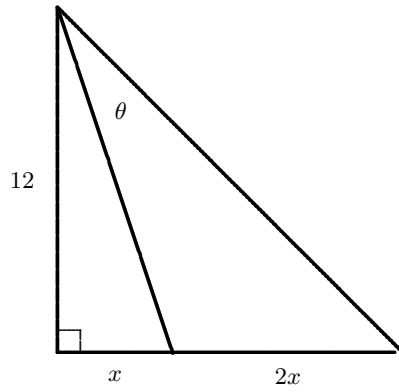
