

## Grading Scale for Talks

1. **Topic of Presentation-10 points** Does your presentation effectively present your topic in the allotted time (15-20 minutes)? Have you avoided trying to do too much or too little in the allotted time.
2. **Use of Beamer-10 points** Does your presentation effectively use the Beamer package? Are your slides error-free and coherent?
3. **Division of Labor-10 points** Do all members of your group seem to have an equal share in presenting your talk. Did all participate equally and cohesively in creating the Beamer Document.
4. **Presentation Style-15 points** Does your talk connect with your audience? Are you enthusiastic about your topic, and do you present it in an effective manner?
5. **References-5 points** Do you cite the appropriate references both during and after your talk?

A note on typesetting: In order to produce the .pdf file of your work, you'll want to compile it from the command line. Follow the following steps:

- Open a terminal window (there should be an icon on the top line of your screen for this)
- Change to the directory which has your Beamer Presentation Document and ancillary materials.
- Type the command "pdflatex XXX.tex", where XXX is replaced by the name of your document.
- If compilation is successful, view your .pdf file in Acrobat Reader by typing "acroread XXX.pdf"
