As the syllabus stated, one of the main objectives of this class is to put together a long-form project. We'll discuss the deadlines later, but today we'll practice some library skills in getting the project started.

Assignment:

1. Think about a possible thesis or subject for your long-form project (you can change your mind later), and a research question that interests you (it should be something about LLMs).

2. Find 2 possible sources of information that you could use to help you answer your research question. Begin creating an annotated bibliography for your sources.
 - a. Cite the source correctly according to MLA, APA, Chicago or other style you are using.

 - b. For each source, write 1-3 sentences about the content of the source (summary) and another 1-3 sentences evaluating why you would use it for this project – or why you would not use it

 - c. Evaluate your source using the SIFT method or with credibility cues. Is this source trustworthy or fit to use to answer your research question? Why or why not?
