

## Note About Software

Here we discuss setting up the software used in the lab for your home computer.

- LaTeX and TeXmaker are free for us to use on our home computers. There is a nice summary of links to the software at

- Maple: Whitman has a license for a certain number of copies. We are experimenting with letting students check out copies from home, but this may end if we ever run out of licenses (a license is checked out when you begin Maple, and checked back in when it shuts down).

The files are here to download: `http://math.whitman.edu/Maple-17/`

The instructions are in the **README** file. Basically, just download the installer you need (64 or 32 bit versions of Windows, Mac or Linux), then start the program.

**IMPORTANT: Choose to install using the network license option.** Use `math.whitman.edu` as the license server.
