

Exam Notes- Canvas, Math 244, Fall 2020

- I think I've gotten a pretty good handle on Canvas' internal quiz feature, so we're going to give it a go next week for the exam.
- My plan is to have the exam available for a couple of days.
 - You'll be able to start the exam when it is convenient for you. When you begin, a timer will also start. I'm planning on the exam taking approximately 50 minutes, but I will give you 90 minutes total (this includes time to upload your answers).
 - What should I have ready before my exam?

You should probably have your textbook, your notes and homework, and optionally the class website (in addition to Canvas) open. Have some clean paper and a pencil or pen for uploads.

There are two websites you may use: An online calculator (linked on our website), and the online direction field plotter. You don't need to use the online calculator if you already have one.

No other computing is allowed. No other sites on the internet are allowed; you'll need to sign a "pledge" statement to that effect on the exam.
 - I'll try to put all of the "file uploads" towards the end of the exam. You should be prepared to pause and upload your work as you go.
- Review materials will be posted very soon (hopefully on or before Friday).
- On Canvas, I have a "Sample Exam" that you can try out anytime to get used to the format (Under the "Quizzes" tab)- Please try it out a couple of days before you want to take the real thing, so you'll know what to expect.
- Special situations: If you have arranged for accommodations on the exam due to a learning disability, then you should hear from me before Monday- otherwise, please let me know. Hopefully with availability over two days, everyone can find a time that will suit them (even if you are in a significantly different timezone!).
- If there is a computer crash or something similar, send your work directly to me by email- the time stamps are usually close so that I can see you're on time. It is harder to organize this way, but it is available as a last resort.

My hope is that everything will run smoothly, but since this is our first time, please don't get too excited if there are technology issues- Just let me know and we'll find a workaround.
