How to put Maple on your home computer

We have a site license for Maple that allows us to have about 25 students checking out a Maple license at the same time. When you install Maple on your home machine and start it up, Maple will go to Whitman's license server to check out one of the licenses- That's why you may run Maple on your home computer.

To put Maple on your home machine, first in your web browser, type the following address:

http://math.whitman.edu/Maple-17/
```

On this page, you will see a file called UserManual-M17.pdf, which you can download and read if you would like- This is Maple's user's manual.

There is a file called **README**. Be sure you read this carefully- It gives you instructions for setting up Maple. In particular, notice that

During the installation choose accept the defaults, except choose the **network** license option and use "winapp.whitman.edu" as the license server and "27001" as the port number.

These are not the default options, so be careful! In particular, if you install Maple and it asks you for a password, you chose the wrong options. If you have trouble, ask your instructor.
