

# Homework 1: Oral Presentations

Using Beamer, create a 5 minute presentation covering the solution of one of the oral exam questions. We'll take turns on Thursday giving our presentations.

**For the presentation:** Overleaf will allow you to download your presentation as a PDF file. In class, you can either log into the classroom computer (either access your Google drive from there or bring a USB drive with the PDF on it) or bring your laptop with the PDF on it.

After class, upload the PDF file to Canvas (due by 11:59 PM)

## Things we'll look for:

- **Delivery:** Eye contact, volume of your voice (speak to the back of the room).
- **Math:** Variables defined? Correct solution?
- **Slides:** Is the work organized or a "word salad"?
- **Timing:** 5:00 minutes ( $\pm$  30 seconds). It may take some time between talks to switch speakers.
- We'll give each speaker a "grade": 1 is for "needs work", 2 is for satisfactory, with a few things needing improvement, and 3 is when it works without improvement.
